Important note about Safeguarding

If you share information with us that makes us worry that <u>you or someone else</u> <u>might be at risk of harm</u> then the "condition for processing" will be to carry out what is called "**obligations in the field of social protection law**".

This means we do not need to get your consent to process any of your data because we have a **legal duty** to report these concerns to people who we believe "need to know" (e.g. the police, social services etc) and provide them with any information they need.

More details of this can be found in our **safeguarding policy**, which you can download from our website or we can send to you on request.

Date Protection	'Data' means any personal information that we (Beacon Films CIC) might collect and store about you
2021	Each year, we will ask you whether we can keep your data for one more year
	If you do not fill in the form giving us permission to do this, we will keep your data for 6 more months . Then if after that we still haven't heard from you, we will delete your data.

•	You can ask us to delete your data at any time.

	Hard copies of your data get stored in a lockable filing cabinet in the Beacon Films office
	Electronic versions of your data get stored in our Dropbox account. This is only accessible via password that only Beacon Films staff have access to.
Dropbox	Any data relating to safeguarding is kept in a special Dropbox folder that can only be accessed by a small number of staff and has a dual authentication lock.
